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Ready to Buy in 2025? Five Steps to Help You Plan

If 2025 is the year you have decided to purchase a new home – whether as a first-time buyer or a seasoned home owner – the best time to start preparing is now. Following these five simple strategies will help place you in an ideal position to find a home that is a good fit for you and your family.

1. Take a Closer Look at Your Credit Score

You can move forward with a home purchase with a much lower down payment. Two factors that primarily impact your down payment amount are the home's price and the type of home loan you secure. In addition to your down payment, you must budget for loan fees and closing costs.

4. Evaluate Your Needs

Put pen to paper, outline what you need and want in a new home and create a “must have” list. Start by thinking about why you're

ready to purchase a new home. Maybe you need a bigger space or want to move to a school district that fits your family's needs. Creating a list of what you need in your new home will save you time when you are ready to start looking. Your next home may not meet every item on your priority list, so you must decide what factors you can compromise on and how you can stay within your budget.

5. Sell Your Current Home.

If buying your home this year is contingent upon selling your home, you should be prepared if the timing doesn't align perfectly. Another consideration is to ensure you have sufficient funds on hand if you cannot have concurrent home closings. A real estate agent can help you navigate the transitions. A buyer or seller market makes a difference in timing the transaction, and a real estate agent can shed light on local market factors. 🏡

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A Closer Look at the Costs of Building a New Home

If you're in the market for a new home, you may wonder about the factors contributing to the home's total cost. The National Association of Home Builders (NAHB) recently published a Cost of Construction Survey, which details the various costs of building a typical new single-family home. Many of the results show that the percentage contribution of each component has remained relatively consistent in recent years.

According to the 2024 survey of home builders, the biggest single component of a new home's total sales price is construction costs, which accounts for around 64.4%. For example, the sales price of a \$665,298 house would likely factor in construction costs of approximately \$428,215, or 64.4%.

Survey respondents broke down construction costs into eight major construction stages:

- Interior finishes (e.g., cabinets, drywall, flooring): 24.1%
- Major system rough-ins (e.g. electrical, HVAC, plumbing): 19.2%
- Framing: 16.6%
- Exterior finishes (e.g., roofing, windows): 13.4%
- Foundations: 10.5%
- Site work (e.g., architecture, building/permit/impact fees): 7.6%
- Final steps (e.g., driveway, landscaping): 6.5%
- Other costs: 2.1%

The share of construction costs to the total price of a new home is the highest since NAHB first produced the survey in 1998. Some of the factors that contribute to the construction costs are the ongoing skilled labor shortages and building material price increases.

The average single-family home size in the 2024 survey was 2,647 sq. ft. of finished floor space, an increase of 86 sq. ft. from 2022. From 2015 to 2022, the average square footage of a home trended downward. Constructing homes with smaller square footage in recent years is a response by builders to meet the current housing affordability challenges buyers face.

Though building practices and the cost of labor, land and materials can vary widely across the country, these national averages provide an overall snapshot for the building industry. 

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Top Compromises Buyers Will Make to Reach Homeownership

A home is one of the most significant purchases a person will make. There is no question that the cost of purchasing a home has been challenging recently. Yet, despite some affordability hurdles, many individuals remain interested in buying a house to invest in their future. Home buyers are willing to make particular exterior and interior compromises to achieve the goal of homeownership.

A recent NAHB study on housing preferences asked home buyers about which specific compromises they would be willing to make to achieve homeownership. One of the top compromises is the actual size of the property. The survey revealed that 39% of buyers say accepting a smaller lot is the path to affording a home. And nearly 4 out of 10 buyers would be willing to give up land in exchange for owning a home.

A smaller lot is one compromise, but what about sacrificing space within a home? A majority of buyers (53%) said they would be willing to have a smaller home office and dining room (52%) to save on square footage. Also, a loud and clear message from home buyers to builders is to leave the kitchen (only 21% would want that smaller) and closet space (22%) alone.

It's not always about the space; it's about the layout. New homes offer modern floor plans and designs to optimize space and comfort at home. Older homes do not provide the spaciousness that many new homes have. Contemporary designs are not limited to flexible spaces. New homes have the latest technological features and appliances. Also, upgrades and remodels are not in the immediate future with a new home, so you can focus on settling into your new home. 🏠

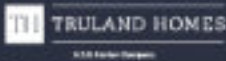

Almost half (48%) of the owner-occupied homes were built before 1980, according to a recent National Association of Home Builders (NAHB) analysis of U.S. Census data.

A professional remodeler ensures your home's construction is completed safely and meets high-quality standards. Consider Reviews and Referrals. A professional remodeler will likely have a website and/or social media accounts that showcase previous home renovation projects. Review sites such, as Angi, Houzz or HomeAdvisor, may also have photos of completed projects and reviews. Generally, online reviews can have a mix of positive and negative comments. It is important to focus on descriptions of experiences and qualities that are essential to you as a customer. Reliable referrals can also come from family, friends and neighbors. Ask them about the type of remodeling work completed on comparable homes with similar schedules.

Do Your Homework. A good rule of thumb is double-checking that your potential contractor has a good track record. Your local or state office of consumer protection will likely have information about the contractor you are researching. You should be able to verify that the remodeler has the appropriate licenses and registrations. A qualified remodeler will also have a physical office, mailing address, phone, and email.

Connect and Ask Questions. A qualified remodeler will be forthright and answer any questions you may have about their professional experience, knowledge of the homes in your area and details related to the residential building permitting process. Ask about how long their business has been in the community and request references. You also want to ensure the contractor carries insurance that protects you from claims arising from property damage or job site injuries.

Discuss Project Specifics and Contracts. It is important to agree with your contractor about the specifics and the scope of your project. A qualified remodeler will provide a written estimate and a detailed contract before beginning the work. The contract should clearly spell out what work will and will not be performed and provide a payment schedule.

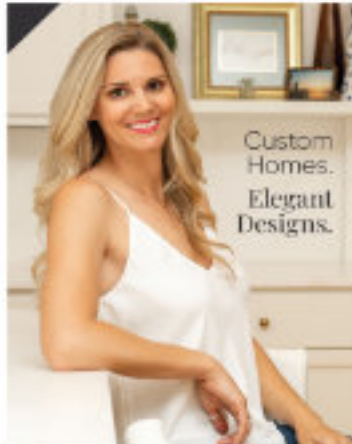
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Aging-in-Place Trends: What Upgrades Home Owners Actually Want



With rising housing costs and stagnant interest rates, home owners are increasingly wanting to enjoy their retirement years in the comfort and familiarity of their own homes. The “aging in place” (AIP) approach affords home owners the ability to make upgrades now that allow them to live independently in their own home for longer, regardless of age or ability.

In response, 73% of remodelers have indicated that AIP project requests have significantly or somewhat increased over the past five years, according to the National Association of Home Builders (NAHB). The two most common reasons home owners request these projects are planning for future needs (91%) and living with older parents (48%).

What do you think would be the most important home features to have as you age?

Bathroom Safety Starts with Smart Design

The bathroom is a top priority for AIP remodeling, with the three most requested upgrades happening there. The goal is to reduce risks and keep people safe by adding convenient elements. In 2024, grab bars were the most common AIP request, with 87% of remodelers reporting this job in the last year. This was followed by curbless showers (78%) and installing higher toilets (71%). Together, these updates make the bathroom safer for those with limited mobility, while also blending seamlessly into modern bathroom design.

Making Main Living Areas more Accessible

Beyond the bathroom, home owners are looking to make day-to-day movement easier. Wider doorways are a common solution, as 52% of remodelers made this change in 2024. This allows for smoother navigation with mobility aids, especially in tight areas like hallways. Another common improvement in-

cludes adding a bedroom to the entry level (37%) to avoid the physical strain caused by stairs.

Entryways to Welcome Everyone

The transition into and out of the home is another critical area. More and more, homeowners are opting for ramps or lower-threshold entries in places like the garage or front porch (44%). These reduce the need to step up or down and are particularly helpful for those using mobility aids. Inside, non-slip flooring is also gaining popularity (26%) as a subtle upgrade that significantly reduces risk in high-traffic areas.

While these upgrades can be straightforward, proper installation matters. Building professionals who have earned the NAHB Certified Aging-in-Place Specialist designation have received training on how to build or renovate a home so that the occupants can live in it safely, independently and comfortably during retirement. 🌐



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Today's Builders Are Responding to Home Buyer Preferences

America's home builders closely follow the preferences of today's home buyers to ensure their needs and wants are being met. For example, builders added square footage in new homes at the height of the pandemic, as people used their houses for more purposes, including work. The trend is shifting to smaller homes partly due to housing affordability concerns. According to research conducted by the National Association of Home Builders (NAHB), builders are responding to home buyer preferences, especially when it comes to square footage and features.

Home buyers continue to look toward smaller homes, with the median home size dropping from 2,200 square feet in 2023 to 2,150 square feet in 2024 — the lowest in 15 years — after holding strong at 2,300 square feet from 2019-2022. However, builders are adding to overall living space by tacking on more porches and patios, with 68% and 64% of new homes, respectively, incorporating these features.

Although home size preferences are trending smaller, exact sizes differ by generation. Millennials prefer larger homes, with a median of 2,408 square feet, while boomers are looking to downsize to an average of 1,869 square feet. Gen X and Gen Z are looking for homes around 2,250 square feet.

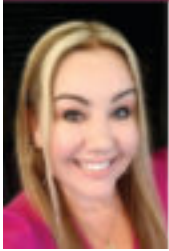
Each generation is progressively more open to having a smaller home with higher-quality products and amenities versus a larger home with fewer amenities. More than half of Gen Z (53%) and millennials (52%) are willing to compromise, increasing to 61% for Gen X and 70% for boomers.

Regarding home features, some preferences, such as home technology are shared across all generations. For example, top technology features most wanted by new and recent home buyers include security cameras, wireless security systems and video doorbells — highlighting a key interest in safety. Consistently popular features, such as the great room, laundry room and garage storage, remain important for most buyers of all generations. ●

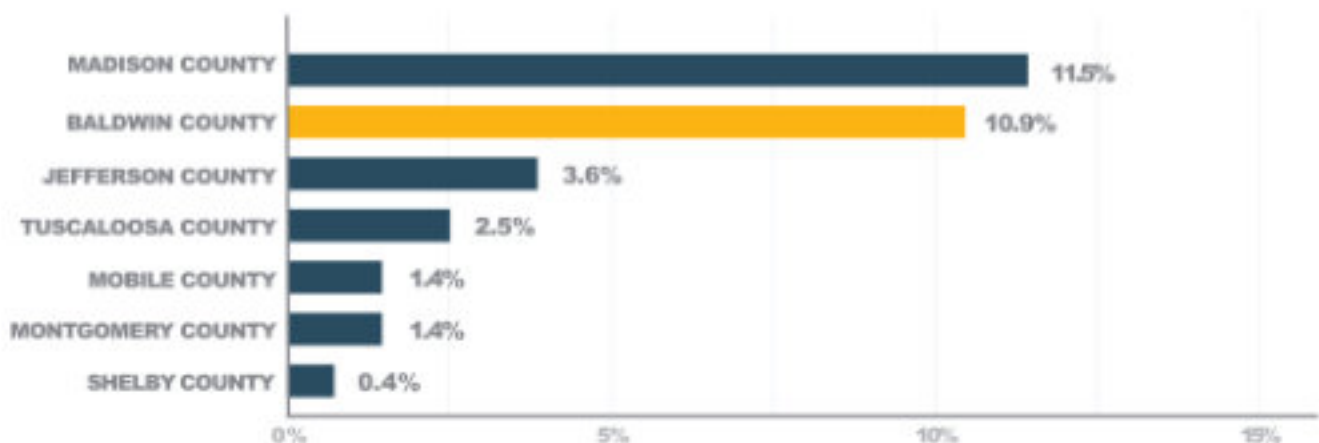

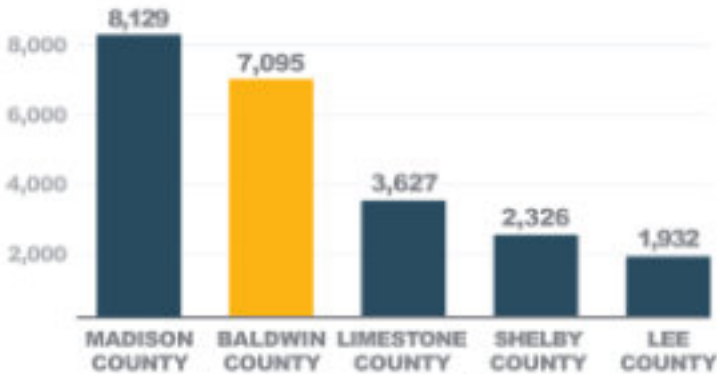

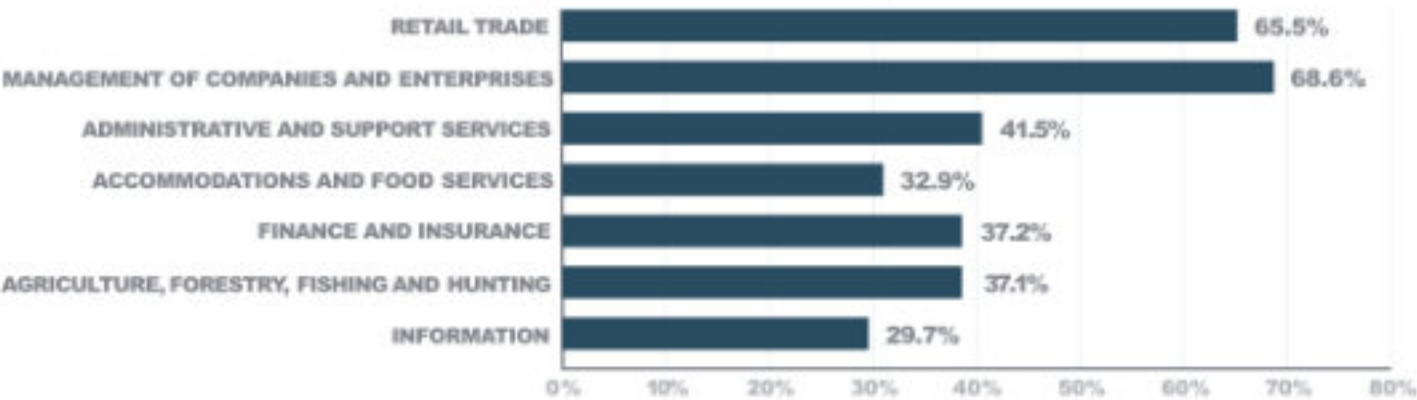

BALDWIN COUNTY TOTAL EMPLOYMENT



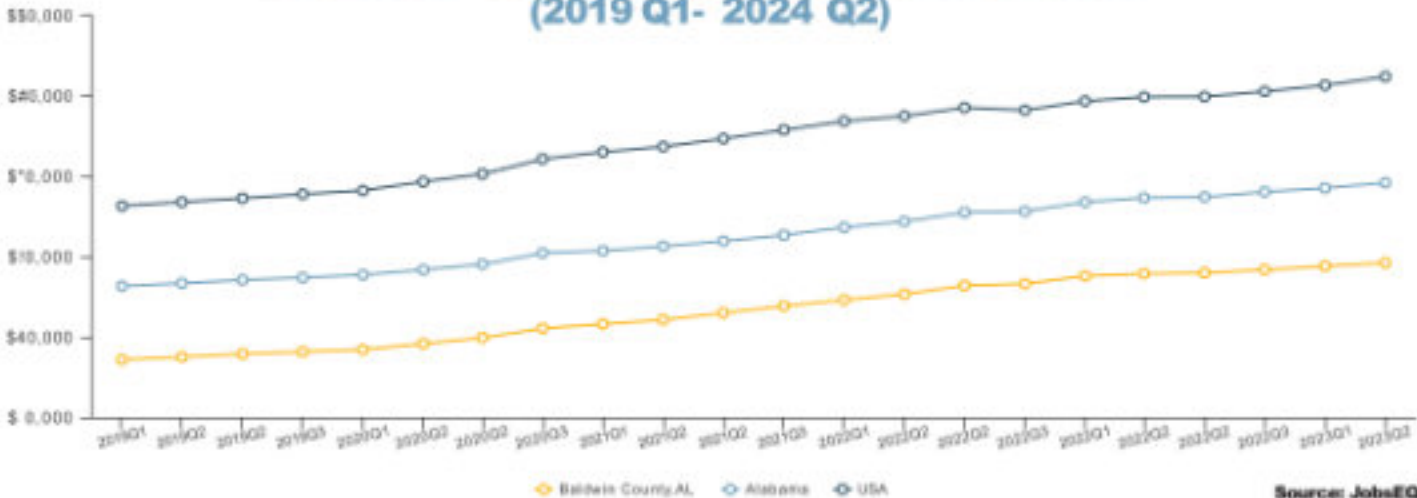

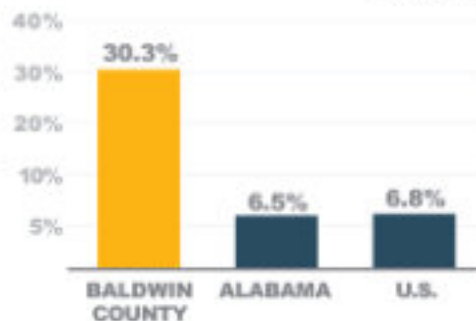

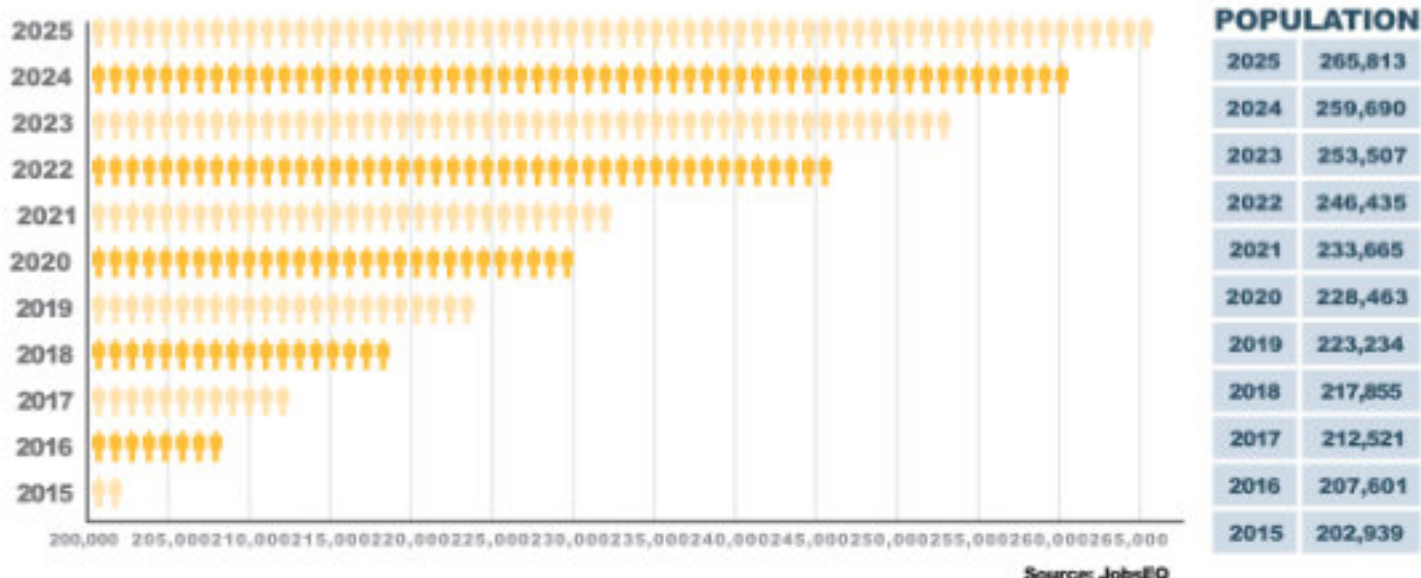

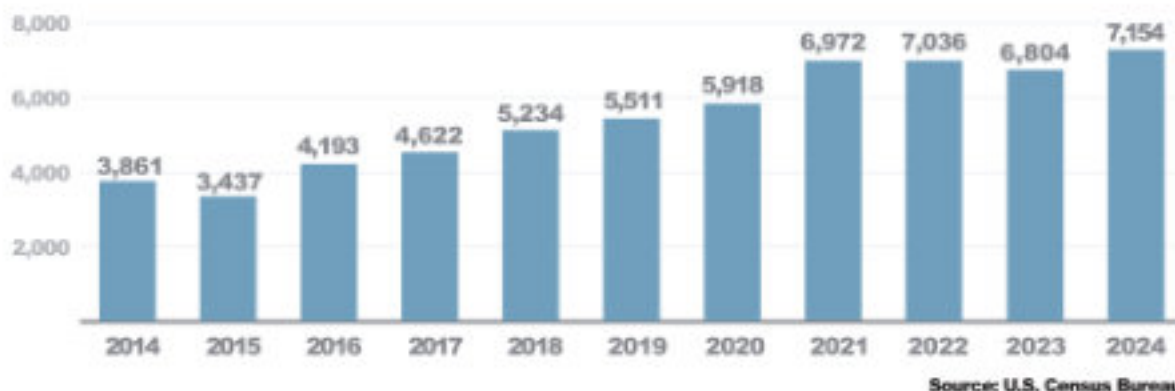

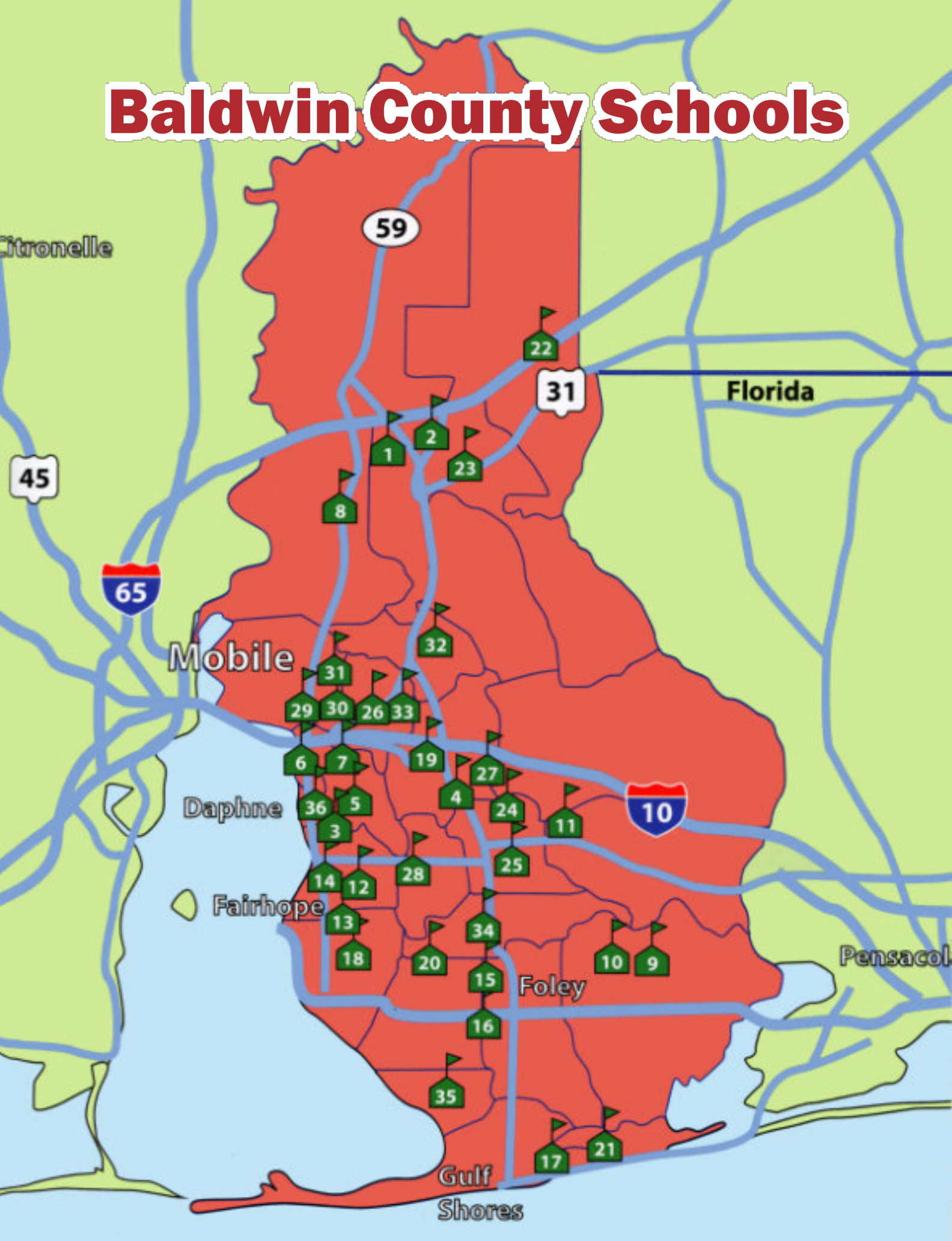
BALDWIN COUNTY POPULATION GROWTH

3. Verify Credentials

Ask to see the contractor's license (it's credit card sized, paper or digital). Verify their status with the HBLB by calling 1-800-304-0853 or visiting hblb.alabama.gov.

4. Get It In Writing

Always get a written contract —including the contractor's name, license number, contact info, job description, start/end dates, and total cost.

5. Pay Safely & Protect Yourself

Never pay in full upfront. Wait until the work is done—and insure all subcontractor are paid. Also ask for proof of insurance (workers' comp and liability) and obtain multiple references—even for local contractors.

6. Beware of Scams & Price Gouging

If a state of emergency is declared, **price gouging protections** kick in. Be cautious of inflated quotes—pricing that's over 25% higher than the pre-storm average may be illegal. Request multiple quotes.

Multigenerational Households Grow in Popularity

The popularity of multigenerational homes is growing, with more families choosing to live together under one roof. Family households of three or more generations, or “multigenerational households,” have become increasingly popular in recent years. According to the Pew Research Center, the number of Americans living in a multigenerational family household today is about four times larger than in the 1970s.

The Pew data reveals that 59.7 million U.S. residents live with multiple generations under one roof. Several factors are driving this trend. Recently, the COVID-19 pandemic increased multigenerational living arrangements as families came together for financial or health-related reasons. Other recent factors include rising housing costs and adult children staying home longer.

Population growth in the United States is also driving this trend. According to Pew, the population increase includes foreign-born Asian, Black and Hispanics who are more likely to live under one roof. The

demographic shift is apparent in home buying trends. A recent National Association of Home Builders (NAHB) survey of home buyers shows that half of African Americans (50%) and Hispanics (53%) say they prefer a home designed for multiple generations.

Multigenerational households also form so that grandparents can help care for their grandchildren, and their children can care for them as they age. This type of arrangement can also lessen financial burdens, with several generations contributing to the mortgage payment and eliminating expenses of childcare, retirement housing or professional caregiving environments.

Home builders and remodelers are building and renovating homes to meet the needs of multigenerational households. These designs allow many generations of the same family to live together under one roof yet have private areas and combined living space.

Features of multigenerational home plans can include in-law suites within the main home with separate areas for independent living. These often have kitchenettes, ensuite bathrooms, and sometimes private entrances from the street. In addition, they frequently include “universal design” features, which focus on maximum usability by people of all ages and abilities. Examples include walk-in showers, smooth flooring transitions, and cabinets with pull-out drawers.

Building professionals who have earned the NAHB Certified Aging-in-Place Specialist (CAPS) designation have received training on how to build or renovate a home so that the occupants can live in the home **safely, independently and comfortably**, regardless of their age or ability level. While most CAPS professionals are remodelers, an increasing number are general contractors, designers, architects, and healthcare professionals. ●

High Paying Career Paths in Residential Construction



TResidential construction careers are professionally and financially rewarding. A career in the skilled trades, such as carpentry or plumbing, doesn't require a four-year degree. Additionally, individuals who enroll in an apprenticeship program can earn income while they learn their trade.

Upon completion of their training, skilled trades professionals have strong earning potential. According to the latest Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS) and a National Association of Home Builders (NAHB) analysis, half of the payroll workers in construction earn more than \$58,500 and the top 25% make at least \$79,450. The BLS publishes wages for more than 400 occupations in construction. Here is a closer look at the median salaries among the highest-paid wages in construction based on the most recent data available (2023).

Brickmasons

Bricklaying is a cornerstone of the construction industry. Masonry construction encompasses many materials, including brick, stone, marble, granite, travertine, limestone, concrete block, glass block, stucco, and tile. The median annual wage for brickmasons is \$59,890.

Electricians

Consistently sought after in the job market are skilled electricians. The median wage for electricians in 2023 was \$60,720. Electricians use their analytical skills to diagnose electrical problems and utilize a wide range of tools and technologies to complete their tasks.

Carpenters

Carpenters are in high demand across all construction sectors, consistently finding employment throughout various project phases. This translates to exceptional job security within the industry. Top carpenters

are known for their critical thinking and meticulous attention to detail. Skilled carpenters enjoy a competitive annual salary of \$57,300.

First-Line Supervisors

Once you have enough experience, you will have the opportunity to be a project manager. First-line supervisors are vital in ensuring completed projects are on time and within budget. The median wage for an employee in this role is \$76,960.

Plumbers

In 2023, the median wage for plumbers was \$61,380. They are responsible for the installation, repair, and maintenance of piping systems in residential, commercial, and industrial settings. Beyond technical expertise, plumbers excel in communication and problem-solving, ensuring customer satisfaction. As complex water systems are integral to modern structures, the demand for skilled plumbers remains steady.

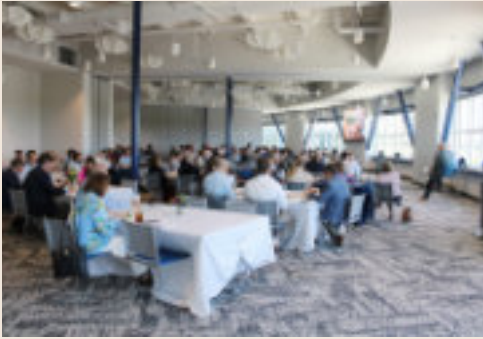
