



SCHOLARSHIPS FOR STUDENTS IN THE BUILDING INDUSTRY

2026 Application

The Baldwin County Home Builders Association and its Associate Council is offering scholarships for area students. Qualifying students must be enrolled in construction-related studies at a technical school or college. To date, the Association has awarded \$141,600 in scholarships to help students in Baldwin County prepare for careers in the home building industry. The scholarship Committee will be charged with the administration of the scholarships, which will be awarded in accordance with its guidelines and upon the committee's approval.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Applicants must be a permanent resident of Baldwin County. Exceptions will be taken under consideration if the applicant is a child of a BCHBA Member.
- Applicant must be a high school graduate or equivalent.
- Applicant must have taken the ACT or SAT test for entering college, and have sufficient score to permit entry in the college, business school or technical school if such a score is required for entry.
- Applicant must be in need of financial assistance, which must be clearly indicated on the application.
- Applicant must be furthering their education in the housing industry or a related field.
- Applicant must be sponsored by a member of the Baldwin County Home Builders Association.

Scholarship funds are paid directly to the college, business school or technical school and must be within the school year for which awarded. Applicants may compete in succeeding years but must reapply and meet all application criteria as if applying for the first year. All applications must be completed in detail with all enclosures, information and signatures.
